### **Fr. Toribio's Corner:**

Dear parishioners: The Kingdom is greater than the Church!

Through the parish, the diocese and all its groups, movements and associations, the Church, shapes and channels our commitment to Christ. Through these groups we relate to each other and to other communities, to other parishes, to the whole Church. Although everyone is in different latitudes, we pray together, we celebrate together and we are encouraged to continue working for the Kingdom of God.

Today's Gospel reminds us of something very important: the Kingdom of God is greater than the small group of disciples of Jesus, than those of our parish, our community, our group or our Church. The Kingdom embraces all men of goodwill. Without exception. Whether or not they are baptized ... whether or not they are from our church. It is enough that we open our eyes and take off our glasses of prejudice to see the number of men and women who, even using a different name to call God, have made their lives a service to others. We build the Kingdom when we join efforts to make this world a more just and supportive place. All men and women of good will enter the Kingdom of God, because they are the ones who build it with us. Even if they do not know Jesus: the incarnate God who is in favor of the Life of man.

This week, and beyond, let us seek to be more inclusive and collaborative in the search for the common good. Let us be brothers and sisters of all those who, under any faith or ideology, dedicate themselves to doing good. Jesus is with them and with us too.
