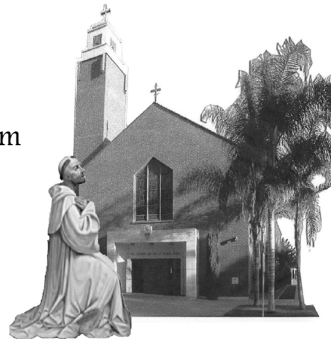

Dear Parishioners:

Look, there is something new: it's already sprouting, don't you see it?", Says the first reading of Isaiah. What is that new? The answer is in the Gospel of this Sunday. Jesus' reaction is what is new. He decides between fulfilling the law or saving an adulterous woman. He has no doubt, although he seems unaware when he writes with his finger on the floor. He makes a proposal: "that only he who is free from sin, throw the first stone." "They, hearing it, have been sneaking one by one, beginning with the oldest, until the last", until Jesus and the woman are left alone. There is no doubt, something new is sprouting.

Jesus points us to the attitude that we Christians must have: condemn sin ("go ahead sin no more") and save the sinner ("I do not condemn you either"). We resemble the Pharisees when we give more importance to the rules than to life. Because, even if she is a sinner, this woman's life counts, it can be recovered. You have to believe in God who is able to make her new and turn a sinner into a different woman, and you have to believe that the conversion of others is possible. We have much to learn from Jesus' way of acting, on many other occasions in the dignity of people, we only see and judge their actions. Let's not inhabit within us the desire to condemn. Let us show to the extreme for compassion, for mercy, to save the one who is lost, who can always resume his life.

DEAR GRANDMA:

I greet you again with great pleasure and I hope that the last days of Lent are a good opportunity for prayer and recollection. Last week, I was preaching a mission from Monday to Friday in Spanish. We talked about the 4 Lenten practices recommended by the Holy Mother Church for thousands of years. These are Fasting, Penance, Prayer and Almsgiving. A good number of people attended and I was very satisfied with their interest. I am very sorry that some groups and ministries have preferred to hold meetings instead of attending our parish activity designed specially for them. I hope that next year, attendance will be greater. Have a blessed week. I hope Easter will be for you a true cause of joy and rejoicing.

Queridos hermanos:

"Mirad que realizo algo nuevo: ya está brotando, ¿no lo notáis?", nos dice la primera lectura de Isaías. ¿Qué es eso nuevo?, la respuesta está en el Evangelio de este domingo. Lo nuevo es la reacción de Jesús. Decide entre cumplir la ley o salvar a una mujer adúltera. No le tiembla la mano porque no tiene ninguna duda, aunque parece desentendido cuando seguía escribiendo con el dedo en el suelo. Les lanza un desafío: *"El que esté sin pecado, que tire la primera piedra"* y sigue escribiendo. *"Ellos, al oírlo, se fueron escabullendo uno a uno, comenzando por los más viejos, hasta el último"*, hasta que Jesús y la mujer se quedan solos. No hay duda, algo nuevo está brotando.

Jesús nos apunta la actitud que tenemos que tener los cristianos: condenar el pecado ("en adelante no peques más") y salvar al pecador ("tampoco yo te condeno"). Nos parecemos a los fariseos cuando damos mayor importancia a las normas que a la vida. Porque, aunque sea una pecadora, la vida de esta mujer cuenta, puede ser recuperada. Hay que creer en Dios que es capaz de hacerlo todo nuevo y convertir a aquella pecadora en una mujer distinta, y hay que creer que la conversión de los demás es posible. Tenemos mucho que aprender de la manera de actuar de Jesús, en demasiadas ocasiones no creemos en la dignidad de las personas, sólo vemos y juzgamos sus acciones. No anidemos en nosotros el deseo de condenar. Busquemos hasta el extremo la compasión, la misericordia, para salvar al que suponemos perdido, que siempre puede reanudar su vida.

ESTIMADA TIA TOTA:

Te saludo de nuevo con mucho gusto y deseo que los días últimos de la cuaresma sean para ti bien aprovechados. La semana pasada estuve impartiendo ejercicios espirituales de lunes a viernes en español. Hablamos de las 4 prácticas cuaresmales recomendadas por la Santa Madre Iglesia desde hace miles de años. Estas son el Ayuno, la Penitencia, la Oración y el Diezmo. Asistió un buen número de personas y me quedé muy satisfecho por su interés. Lamento mucho que algunos grupos y ministerios hayan preferido sesionar en lugar de asistir a los mismos. Espero que el próximo año, la asistencia sea mayor. Me despido esperando que la Pascua sea para ti una verdadera causa de alegría y regocijo.
